

Categories of Employment

The Naples CHRM Office manages recruitment for four different categories of employees: NATO International Civilian, Local Status, Temporary Civilians, and Crisis Response Operations.

- NATO International Civilian posts are divided into four categories, which are described at the following link: http://www.jfcnaples.nato.int/civilian_personnel/page40544123.aspx
- Local status vacancies are generally administrative and support posts under host nation labour legislation. In the hiring of civilian personnel with local status, preference will be given to Italian citizens. Citizens of other NATO countries may be employed only if there are not enough qualified Italian citizens available and if they are residents of Italy or have been granted residence in accordance with Italian law.
- Temporary posts are established in response to short-term or extraordinary operational requirements. Eligibility limitations are stated in the vacancy announcement for the specific post.
- Crisis Response Operations (CRO) vacancies international staff posts created in response to limited duration requirements in support of peacekeeping operations under the authority of JFC Naples. Interested applicants are invited to note caveats which may apply to eligibility, contract duration and renewal, or other conditions of employment and which appear in the individual vacancy announcement. Duty station, which may be in Naples or at forward operational commands, is stated in the job description.
